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METHODOLOGY

The study was conducted using a quasi-experimental design, involving two groups of participants. The intervention group received the proposed intervention, while the control group received standard care. Data was collected at baseline, post-intervention, and follow-up.

The study was approved by the WHO Regional Office for the Eastern Mediterranean. The intervention was implemented by trained health workers. Data was collected using standardized questionnaires. The results were analyzed using statistical software.
